Cloud Dough Ingredients-

8 cups of flour
1 cup baby oil

- **Measure 8 cups of flour into a large bowl and add 1 cup of baby oil.**
- **Mix and squeeze the ingredients with your hands to incorporate until the dough holds together when squeezed.**
