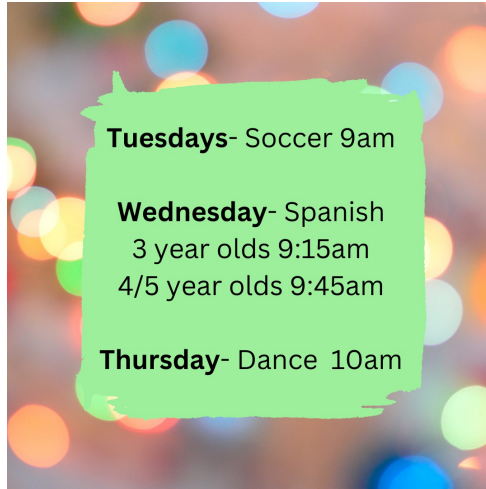
Please stop by the Child Development center office to see the cut Owl Babies that Mrs. Murphy and Mrs. Van Vorst's class made.

Please bring a full change of clothes for your child. Put it in a ziplock bag and label it with your child's name. This will be kept in the classroom just incase.

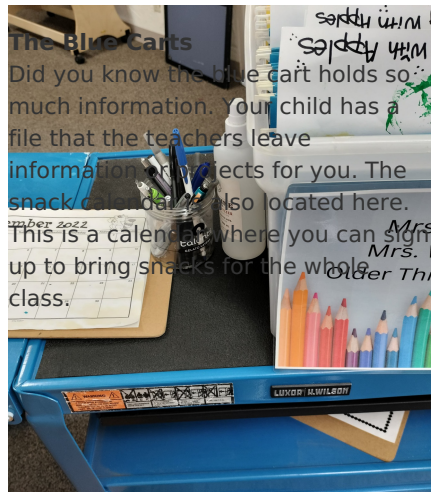
