**How to Make Marbled Eggs** 

What you will need· vegetable oil, white vinegar, food coloring, 11:10am mugs (one for each color), spoons (one for each color)

- 1. Place one tablespoon of oil and one tablespoon of vinegar into each mug. Add a different color of food coloring to each mug. Fill to 3/4 full of water and stir each one. Each mug should have its own spoon.
- 2. Hold your boiled egg in one hand and stir the liquid in the mug with the spoon using your other hand. Stir it several times to create a whirlpool effect. Immediately remove the spoon, place egg on spoon and lower egg into swirling water.
