Orange Volcano

What You'll Need-

An orange, Knife ,Spoon, bowl, baking soda, vinegar, Food coloring, Measuring glass (to pour vinegar from)

What to Do-

1.Place your orange on a flat surface.

2.Slice the top of the orange off and remove the inside of the orange. We scored the inside of the orange a bit with the knife just to loosen the orange up. Then, scoop the inside of the orange out like you're removing the insides of

a pumpkin you're about to carve!

3. Place your orange in a bowl. Scoop some baking soda into your orange (about a tablespoon).

4. Pour some vinegar into a measuring glass (we used a couple cups) and add some food coloring. Mix well.

Pour the colored vinegar into the orange and watch the fun!
